Board Meeting Update

The meeting began with an extended time of prayer.

HOS Report: Mr. Wrobbel is currently interviewing candidates for the open faculty positions (5th grade, junior high science, music) for the 2008-2009 school year. Stanford Achievement Tests are completed and have been sent for scoring. Report cards will be mailed home after school is out this year. Tours are continuing for interested families, and enrollment for next year already stands at 192. First and second grades are full and we have started waiting lists. We thank God for this provision of 32 new students and are excited about what He is going to do next year! There have been exciting things happening at Trinity Oaks: hatching of ducks and chicks, 4th Grade State Fair, 7th and 8th grade Washington, D.C. trip, book fair, and 2nd-4th grade intramural basketball. The junior high elections and student lock-in are upcoming. Paul reviewed the new Trinity Oaks website, along with future plans. We are expecting at least 64 golfers at Friday’s golf outing and have 11 hole sponsors.

Facilities Report: The Board approved leasing the Bull Valley property to a garden center for the next eight months. Please continue to join the Board in praying for the sale of our current assets and God’s clear direction for our future facilities. A date will be announced soon for a parent update meeting.

HOPE Report: Highlights of recent fundraisers were given and plans for next year were highlighted. The general consensus is that families have enjoyed the restaurant fundraisers and they have been successful. Plans have begun for this year’s float, which will have a Dr. Seuss theme.

Trustee Report: The Board approved a motion from the Trustee Committee to appoint Jen Poppe as a member of the Trinity Oaks Board of Trustees.

Wade Kojima will be leaving the Board after this meeting due to a move to Mississippi. Wade expressed his appreciation to the Board for the years of service together. We will miss the Kojima family and pray for God’s blessings in their new home. The meeting was adjourned with prayer.
