### Financial Assistance Programs

Need-Based Financial Aid:	⇒ Families have the potential to receive up to 40% off their tuition bill. The financial aid process is completed online in a confidential manner through FACTS GRANT & AID. A link can be found in the Online Enrollment/Re-enrollment process in RenWeb.
Each One Reach One (EORO) Referral Program:	⇒ Trinity Oaks offers a discount to families who help us boost our enrollment. A current or new family will receive a \$1,000 tuition credit for each newly enrolled full-time student they refer. The applying family must name the referring family in the application process. (half-day kindergarten \$500 credit; pre-kindergarten \$300 credit; preschool \$200 credit)
Christian Worker Discount:	⇒ Full-time pastors or Christian workers employed at a local church or religious organization may receive up to a 40% credit towards tuition cost.
First & Second Grade Tuition Program:	⇒ A \$500 tuition credit is awarded for each year a student attends Trinity Oaks preschool, prekindergarten, and kindergarten (maximum credit of \$1,500). This credit will be applied evenly towards that student's first and second grade tuition at Trinity Oaks Christian Academy.
High School Tuition Program :	⇒ A \$250 tuition credit is awarded for each consecutive year a student attends grades K-8 at Trinity Oaks (maximum credit of \$2,500). This credit will be applied evenly toward that student's ninth and tenth grade tuition at Trinity Oaks Christian Academy.

New Student Application Fee:	⇒ Preschool \$70 per student ⇒ Pre-kindergarten - High School \$120 per student
New Student Enrollment Fee:	⇒ Preschool & Pre-kindergarten \$170 per student ⇒ Kindergarten—High School \$320 per student
Current Student Re-enrollment Fee:	<b>BEFORE 2/24/2017</b> ⇒ Pre-kindergarten \$140 per student ⇒ Kindergarten—High School \$260 per student <b>AFTER 2/24/2017</b> ⇒ Pre-kindergarten \$170 per student ⇒ Kindergarten—High School \$320 per student
Co-curricular Activity/Sports Fee:	⇒ \$110 per student. Per sport and/or activity

## Tuition Payment Options, Service Fees and Refund Policy

Payment Options:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ One Payment Plan, tuition is due on August 1, 2017</li> <li>⇒ Two Payment Plan, due August 1, 2017 and January 1, 2018</li> <li>⇒ Monthly Payment Plan, due 1st of the month August 2017- May 2018</li> </ul>
Service Fees:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ \$10 late fee will be billed for monthly payments received after the due date.</li> <li>⇒ Returned payment fee \$30.</li> </ul>
Refund Policy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ Application fee, Enrollment fees, Re-enrollment fees and Tuition fees are Non-refundable. Students withdrawn during the school year must be “paid in full” in order to obtain unofficial and official school documents, records or transcripts.</li> </ul>
