## Part-time position

The successful candidate will be a knowledgeable and highly effective educator who can skillfully integrate his or her Christian faith with their academic content area and our curriculum. We are seeking a dedicated and passionate Technology Teacher to join our team at Trinity Oaks Christian Academy. As the Technology Teacher, you will be responsible for teaching students in grades 1-8 various aspects of technology, including computer literacy, digital citizenship, and multimedia skills. Your role will be crucial in fostering a love for technology while incorporating Christian values and principles into the curriculum.

- A teacher who is a devoted and mature follower of Jesus Christ, so that God might be honored in our school, and that our students might be mentored by authentic Christian role models.
- A teacher who is interested in becoming an expert in his or her field, and who is highly qualified in the instructional methodology and pedagogy of their content area and of teaching in general.

- A teacher who is ready to integrate vibrant faith with excellent academics, while providing a safe and healthy classroom environment.

- A teacher who keeps ACSI or state teacher certification up to date in specific teaching area.

### **Essential duties and responsibilities:**

- Teach students in grades 1-8 the fundamentals of computer literacy, including keyboarding, internet usage, and basic software applications.
- Stay updated on current industry trends, advancements in technology, and educational resources to enhance teaching effectiveness.
- Provide hands-on experiences for students to explore multimedia skills, such as graphic design, video editing, and digital storytelling.
- Foster a positive and inclusive learning environment, encouraging collaboration, creativity, and critical thinking.
- Collaborate with other teachers and staff to integrate technology into cross-curricular projects and activities.

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

- A firm understanding of and a passion for working with 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive classroom and rehearsal environments.
- Willingness and ability to foster an affirming yet challenging environment where innovation and creativity are celebrated.
- Willingness and desire to maintain excellent communication with parents; build interactive relationships and address family needs within the parameters of the Trinity Oaks mission.
- Proficient in the use of technology.
- Keeps accurate records, ensuring that students are progressing appropriately and monitors progress through report cards, computer grading program, and other methods.
- Willingness to participate in school-based committees, in cooperative effort with other faculty and staff.
- Seeks out, attends, and participates in ongoing professional development activities.
- Attends and supports school-sponsored student activities, and periodic parent partnership events.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree in Education, Technology, or a related field. A teaching certification is preferred.
- Experience teaching technology to students in grades 1-8, preferably in a school setting.
- Proficient knowledge of computer literacy, and multimedia tools.
- Strong understanding of Christian values and the ability to integrate them into the technology curriculum.

#### **Physical demands:**

Must have the ability to sit and stand for extended periods of time; exhibit manual dexterity to enter data into a computer; to see and read a computer screen and printed material with or without vision aids; hear and understand speech at normal classroom levels, outdoors and on the telephone; speak in audible tones so that others may understand clearly in normal classrooms, outdoors and on the telephone; physical agility to lift up to 25 pounds; to bend, stoop, climb stairs, and reach overhead.
